



Project Progress

Private Utility relocation work is continuing along Main St. CenterPoint Energy plans on completing connecting the new gas main to the existing main within Hwy 55 next week. CenterPoint Energy has coordinated with MNDOT to perform a temporary detour for Right turning traffic turning from westbound Hwy 55 onto Main Street CSAH 20 and all truck traffic from Hwy 55 onto Main Street. Westbound Hwy 55 traffic turning north onto Main Street CSAH 20 will be routed onto Co Rd 50 and Bridge Street. All truck traffic will be routed in the same path. All access from Main Street onto Hwy 55 will not be altered. Advanced notification signage will be provided. Work will begin on April 11th and be completed by April 14th. Service connection work is continuing and expected to be completed early the week of April 18th.

- Areas disturbed by small utility work will be restored to original conditions, once work is completed.
- Temporary service interruptions may occur during private utility relocation but these **WILL** be communicated with affected properties prior to occurring.

The Downtown Improvements project is expected to begin the week of April 18th. Burschville Construction, the removals and utility contractor plans to begin construction by working on the water and storm sewer portions of the project initially. Traffic control devices will begin being installed in the downtown area later on the week of April 11th. During the utility portion of the project, temporary water service shut offs will be performed. Effected properties will be notified prior to the shutdown. The utility portion of

the project is expected to last through the second week in May.

Upcoming Work

- The Week of April 11th. CenterPoint Energy's contractor Michels Corp. will continue transitioning gas serves to the new gas main. Michels will be contacting affected property owners to schedule the transitions. Questions for CenterPoint Energy can be directed to a representative at **612-321-5369**.
- Traffic control devices and signage will be installed the week of April 11th.
