



Project Progress

Private Utility relocation work is continuing along Main St. CenterPoint Energy has completed their gas service relocation work.

Xcel Energy has begun work this week by beginning excavation of the overhead power poles. Xcel will be working next week on transitioning electrical services off of the poles along Main St. Property owners will experience a short power interruption during these switchovers. Xcel WILL notify property owners prior to switching over power. Xcel anticipates their work to be completed by May 6th

Centurylink has begun switching communication services off of the poles along Main St. They will continue transitioning communication services next week and should be completed the week of May 2nd.

- Areas disturbed by small utility work will be restored to original conditions, once work is completed.
- Temporary service interruptions may occur during private utility relocation but these **WILL** be communicated with affected properties prior to occurring.

The Downtown Improvements Project has begun with the utility contractor, Burschville Construction, beginning removals and utility work along the project. They are currently working on relocating hydrants within the project area and replacing water services.

Upcoming Work

- During the week of April 25th Burschville will continue replacing water services and from the existing main to the curb stop shut off valves off of the street and relocating water hydrants. Effected properties will be notified prior to the shutdown. The utility portion of the project is expected to last through the second week in May.
- Burschville Construction will continue removing pavement and sidewalk along Main St. Temporary access will be limited for short periods during this work but the contractor will restore all access with gravel.
- Xcel Energy will be onsite transitioning power services from the existing overhead lines running along main to new locations. Xcel Will notify property owners prior to switching over power.

What can you do?

- It is the City's priority to maintain a safe environment during this project. Safety involves not only the City and the Contractors, but the residents as well. We ask that you:
 - Stay a safe distance from equipment and excavations.
 - Drive with caution throughout the construction project area, obeying construction signs.
 - Respect the construction notices with regards to parking and access to areas of the site.
