Project Update

The Downtown Improvement Project continues to make progress towards completing with concrete sidewalk work being completed this week.

Construction activities are still ongoing in the downtown area with barrels and barricades being used to complete the work alongside traffic. Please be aware of construction workers and drive with caution and courtesy around the construction areas.

The Wright County Pavement improvement Project is continuing along CR 20 with the placement of the final wear course of asphalt being placed in the downtown area next week.

Project Progress

Paver installation continues along the downtown project with paver installation at the crosswalks and light poles being mostly completed from Hwy 55 through Cedar St.

The light pole installation has begun for the downtown project. Please be aware of light pole installation when traveling through the downtown area and stay clear of overhead construction.

Upcoming Work

- Lighting poles and fixtures installation will continue along the downtown area.
- Paver installation should be completed the week of July 18th.
- Boulevard tree installation will occur over the next couple weeks.
- Restoration activities will occur after project work is completed.

What can you do?

- It is the City's priority to maintain a safe environment during this project. Safety involves not only the City and the Contractors, but the residents as well. We ask that you:

 - Stay a safe distance from equipment.
