Project Progress

Project activity will increase next week in the Maplewood Manor area. Below are some of the activities you can expect to see, weather pending:

- Sewer mainline pipe bursting along CR 33. Contractor will be working on the west edge of CR 33, north of Maplewood Manor. Please use caution when travelling in this area. This activity will not affect sewer service to your home. The paved path in this area will be closed until it can be safely re-opened.
- Water main bursting across CR 33. There will be two locations on CR 33 that will have new water main installed under the road by bursting.
- Temporary water is currently being installed. The system has passed the tests and is being hooked up to homes in phase 1. If you have any questions regarding the temporary water system, please contact **Chad Linder with LaTour Construction @ 612-419-0436**.
- Temporary Water shut-offs are scheduled for Monday and Wednesday of next week. You will receive an additional notice informing you of the day your home is scheduled to be shut-off. In the event of weather delay, the shut-off will occur on the next working day.
- Excavations will begin early next week resulting in temporary intersection closures. Please use alternate routes.

- Contractor will be fusing HDPE pipe together for the water main bursts. They will be working on west side of Elmwood Dr. The path in this area will not be accessible during this work.

What can you do?

- Following water shutdowns and switches to temporary water, residents may experience a discoloration in the water on the first use. This discoloration is due to mineral deposits that have settled out of the water over time in the pipes, and have been stirred up during the shutdowns. This water is safe to drink, but the City recommends the homeowner runs an outside faucet, or a basement faucet (cold water) until any water discoloration is gone to prevent the mineral deposits from being run through water heaters, or faucet filters, which may result in the plugging of faucets and water heaters.
- Avoid the area of Elmwood Dr. and Maple Dr. This area will be very congested for the next few weeks.
