Voter Registration information: Register to vote or check your registration at: <u>mnvotes.gov</u>. Already registered? Confirm your registration is correct and up to date. You will need to update your registration if you've moved or changed your name since the last time you voted. You can also register at your polling place on Election Day. You will need to bring proof of residence: ID with your current name and address; or a photo ID **AND** a document, like a utility bill, due or dated within 30 Days of the election with your current residence; or a registered voter from the same precinct who can confirm your address may vouch for you. <u>Find all acceptable proof of residence options at mnvotes.gov</u>. *To find out which candidates and questions you'll be voting on visit: **Voter Information Portal (state.mn.us**)
