MAYOR'S MESSAGE

What happens in MN during the summer? Construction Zones, which have hit Rockford full force this year. Our city staff and engineers continue to work hard on our downtown project with the expectation of a completion date sometime in August. Overall, the project is going very well and everyone is committed to creating as little disruption as possible.

There have, of course, been a few bumps along the way which required Main Street to be closed. At the beginning of the project we found out that the water main and galvanized bolts had deteriorated significantly since being installed in 1994 due to oxidation and electrical interaction. Fortunately, we have set sufficient funds aside in our Water Fund to include this in our current project to avoid more costly water main breaks downtown in the next 5-7 years. By correcting these issues now we will save a significant amount of money by taking advantage of the current project and construction crews on site, and will avoid tearing up Main Street to make spot repairs in the future.

Weekly construction updates are posted on the city website. We appreciate everyone's patience with the detours, construction noise and temporary water. In the end we will be creating an attractive and safer downtown for everyone.

Mark your calendars for Rockford River Days celebration scheduled for August 12^{th} – 14^{th} . Everyone is welcome to enjoy a fun filled weekend of live music, food, corn hole/volleyball/cribbage/Texas hold'em tournaments, beer, fireworks and coronation with the parade at noon on Sunday.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

Summer has arrived, and with it comes warm weather and enjoyment of the great outdoors. The biggest project so far this year has been the Main Street Improvement Project, which now nears completion. The work crews are finishing installation on our expanded sidewalks and tree boxes, with pavers being installed over the month of July. The new street lights should be delivered near the end of June, with tree installation following thereafter. Wright County will be paving Main Street in the near future, with that project also slated to be completed by the end of June. The overall project is on budget and ahead of schedule, with work scheduled to be completed by the end of July.

We know this project has created some difficulty for our community, especially those residents and businesses in and around the Main Street project area. We appreciate and celebrate the positive attitude people have had towards this project and look forward to seeing everyone en-

joy our new Downtown District.

As we move into Fall, we will continue to work with developers like Allen Max Commercial and their project called the Tavern on the Crow. Additionally, we are working on a lot of other projects and developments that will hopefully come to fruition this Fall or in early 2017.

ELECTION INFORMATION

The local elections in Rockford this year include two council members and the mayors seat. The terms for each of these positions are 4 years. Filing for candidacy starts on Tuesday, **August 2, 2016** until Tuesday, **August 16**th at 5pm. The filing fee is \$2.00.

If you are a new resident to the City of Rockford, recently turned 18 or have not voted in the last four years, we encourage you to go online to www.sos.state.mn.us and complete a Voter Registration Application. You may also register to vote on Election Day, but make sure you have ID such as a current driver's license or MN ID card with your correct address. If you have not changed your driver's license you must have a current utility bill and your license. Last day to register before the Primary Election is **July 19, 2016** and the last day to register before the General Election is **October 18, 2016**.

Absentee voting begins June 24, 2016 for the Primary Election and September 23, 2016 for the General Election. Absentee ballots will NOT be available at City Hall to vote in person. Applications are available on-line on the City website (Election tab), at City Hall, 6031 Main Street, or in person at the county where you live:

DOG LICENSES



TALL GRASS & NOXIOUS WEEDS

The city has an ordinance regulating the height of grass. The ordinances states that grass shall not exceed 12" and all noxious weeds and other rank growths of vegetation upon public or private property must be removed.

Typically 5 days are given for tall grass and less if there are noxious weeds.

SWIMMING POOLS

All swimming pools with a capacity of five thousand (5,000) gallons and a depth greater than thirty (30) inches requires a permit and a yearly inspection. Contact City Hall if you need to apply for a permit.
