New Business: Clock Tower on Food Shelf Building

Retired Fire Chief Nathan Buoy stated that he is always available if the Fire Department members ever need anything. He also stated that he has extreme faith in the current Fire Department Membership and their Leadership.

Engineer Steve Heglund stated that it is time for Ver-Tech's biannual permit. He also stated that there is a grant that the city can apply for, for the RRFP to be located at High St and Elm St.

Public Works Jason Styve gave updates on projects Public Works is working on and stated that they are trying to make ice for the skating and hockey rinks.

Councilmember Wyatt Gutzke discussed the pricing for replacement of the Fire Department Heavy Rescue vehicle. He recommends staff and Council review the CIP to be prepared for this future purchase.
