City staff has put together inforrates through 2023. Council reviewed this on 11/24 and on 12/8approved a wasterwater rate increase of \$.40 per 1,000 gallons starting in 2016, with small proposed increases over the next couple years to keep our funds at a positive balance. Please remember to contact City Hall by December 31st if you wish to change your wastewater billing to Averaging or Actual use for 2016.

Beginning January 2016, our recycling will be picked up by Waste Management. This was determined after the council voted on the new contract proposals presented by

Waste Management and Randy's Sanitation. It was a difficult decision to make and we appreciate the excellent service Randy's provided our city.

When the snow does start to fall. please remember to shovel the snow around fire hydrants by your home to enable our Fire Department volunteers to easily find them in case of a fire.

WASTEWATER BILLING CALCULATION (ACTUAL AVERAGING) OPEN UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2015

Historically wastewater rates had only been calculated based on the average water used between November 15th and April 15th and recalculated annually. In 2014 the City Council passed an ordinance to allow residents the choice between being billed for their wastewater use based upon their actual water use or continuing with the old system which averaged winter water use and billed that average as the wastewater usage over the summer months.

All residents in Rockford are assigned the averaging billing system for wastewater unless you contact City Hall between **December 1st and December 31st**, with the change effective for the January billing. This is the only time you can change your wastewater billing calculation.

WASTEWATER RATE INCREASE

Wastewater rates will increase in January. 2016, from \$6.45 to \$6.85 (an increase of \$.40) per 1,000 gallons of use.

2016 BUDGET AND PROPERTY TAX LEVY

The City of Rockford established a 2015 Budget last December with expense totaling \$2,180,258. The city levied \$1,205,30 for operating expenses to provide city services, and \$342,066 to pay the city's long term bond debt. The 2016 Budget is set at \$2,068,094. The levy for operating expenses is \$1,229,779 which represents a increase in operating expenses of \$24,476 or 2.03%%. The city's long term debt has also increased based upon the principal and interest payments due and payable in 2016. These debt service payments increased from the 2015 amount of \$342,066, to the 2016 required amount of \$358,328; which is an increase of \$16,262, or 4.75%. On December 8th following the Truth-In-Taxation Hearing the City Council approved a Property Tax Levy of \$1,588,107; which represents an increase of \$40,738 from the 2015 Property Tax Levy which is an increase of 2.63%.

SNOWMOBILES

SIDEWALK SNOW REMOVAL

In the interest of public safety, the City of Rockford reminds you of the importance of keeping your walkways cleared of snow and ice. City Ordinance 901.04 states that all snow and ice must be removed from public sidewalks 24 hours after the snow or other precipitation causing the condition.

If you live near a fire hydrant, please keep it clear of snow and ice.

SNOW SEASON PARKING

The snow season ordinance is in effect November 1st until April 1st and it shall be unlawful for any person to **park a vehicle** on or within six feet of the **roadway between 2am-6am** OR after **ice accumulation, continuous or intermittent snow fall during which there has been an accumulation of two inches or more of snow** on any street until the same has been plowed or removed from the full width of the roadway. On street parking is prohibited from 4am-6am on ALL non-residential streets regardless of snow. **At NO TIME shall a vehicle be parked upon ANY street in any one place for more than twelve (12) hours**. Please make sure that your guests are aware of these regulations so that they don't end up with a ticket or worse yet, getting towed.

Maintain a safe driving distance behind snow plows.

Persons operating snowmobiles within the city limits **must travel on designated trails**. Snowmobiles are prohibited from any public sidewalk/trail ways provided for pedestrian travel, on private property without the owner's permission, and all other public property unless designated as the snowmobile trail. There is no parking or riding of snowmobiles on the levee or in city parks, per Ordinance 208.

SNOW PLOWING

It is unlawful to plow snow onto ANY city, township, county or state road. Doing so is a violation of state statue and you will be fined.

2016 RECYCLING INFORMATION

The City recently went out for bids for recycling services and received two bids. A seven year contract was awarded to Waste Management.

One-sort recycling containers will be delivered the week of December 28th along with a recycling calendar. Residents are able to keep their old blue recycling bins or return to City Hall or Public Works by January 29h for proper disposal.

Beginning in 2016, residential recycling fees will increase \$4 annually and be billed monthly instead of quarterly. Residents will be billed \$2 each month on their utility bill card (\$24 annually).

Roll cart must be set out at the curb by 7 a.m. Face the lid towards the street and the handle towards the house.

Items for recycle: metal cans, plastic bottles & containers #1-7, glass bottles & jars, paper, flattened cardboard & paperboard, and dairy & juice cartons.
