Project Progress

New Look Construction has continued work on replacing the watermain in Phase 1B this week and will continue into the week of July 25th.

Turf placement will be completed later this year once all work within disturbed areas has been completed.

New Look continued transitioning residents in phase 1B to temporary water during the week and will continue transitioning residents during the week of July 25th. Notices will be provided to residents effected by temporary water shut offs and properties being placed on temporary water service. Residents will be provided notice of any shutdowns which will affect their property ahead of the work taking place.

Any time water is disconnected, whether it be hydrant flushing, short water shutdowns or a change to temporary water, residents may experience a slight discoloration in the clarity of water on the first use. This discoloration in water clarity is due to mineral deposits along the water service line that have settled and are now stirred up during the shutdowns. This water is safe to drink, but the City recommends homeowners run an outside or basement cold water faucet for a few minutes until any water discoloration is gone to prevent the mineral deposits from plugging filters on water faucets and water heaters.

Access to properties within the project area will continue to be provided. Temporary detours may take you in a different direction, but you will always be able to drive to your home or destination.

We do ask that if you don't need to go to a home or business within the project itself, that you take an alternate route around the construction project.

Upcoming Work

- Work on replacing the water mains in phase 1B will continue during the week of July 25th.
- During the week of July 25th New Look Contracting will continue to transition effected properties in Phase 1B to temporary water.

What can you do?

- It is the City's priority to maintain a safe environment during this project. Safety involves not only the City and the Contractors, but the residents as well. We ask that you:
 - Stay a safe distance from equipment and excavations.
 - Drive with caution throughout the construction project area, obeying construction signs.
 - Respect the construction notices with regards to parking and access to areas of the site.
