

# 2022 Infrastructure Improvement Project

## Project Progress

New Look Construction has continued work on replacing the watermain in Phase 1B this week and continue through Mid-August.

All residents in phase 1B are on temporary water and will be transitioned back to permanent water service once the work in this area is completed. Residents will be provided notice of these transitions back to permanent water ahead of it taking place.

Any time water services are transitioned, whether it be hydrant flushing, short water shutdowns or a change from temporary water, residents may experience a slight discoloration in the clarity of water on the first use. This discoloration in water clarity is due to mineral deposits along the water service line that have settled and are now stirred up during the shutdowns. This water is safe to drink, but the City recommends homeowners run an outside or basement cold water faucet for a few minutes until any water discoloration is gone to prevent the mineral deposits from plugging filters on water faucets and water heaters.

Access to properties within the project area will continue to be provided. Temporary detours may take you in a different direction, but you will always be able to drive to your home or destination.

We do ask that if you don't need to go to a home or business within the project itself, that you take an alternate route around the construction project.

## Upcoming Work

- Work on replacing the water mains in phase 1B will continue during the week of August 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Replacement of storm sewer segments in Phase 1A of the project will take place the week of August 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Portions of the concrete curb will be replaced in phase 1A of the project the week of August 1<sup>st</sup>. Any properties affected by the placement of the concrete curbing or pavement will be notified ahead of time.

## What can you do?

- It is the City's priority to maintain a safe environment during this project. Safety involves not only the City and the Contractors, but the residents as well. We ask that you:
  - Stay a safe distance from equipment and excavations.
  - Drive with caution throughout the construction project area, obeying construction signs.
  - Respect the construction notices with regards to parking and access to areas of the site.
