## Project Progress

- Due to the recent heavy rains, crews were not able to complete as much as they had hoped this past week.
- The water main crossings on CR 33 are complete. There will be some work that will still take place along the East side of CR 33, but that should be finished next week.
- Much of the work in the coming week will be near the intersection of Elmwood Dr. and Maple Dr. This intersection will be closed for most of next week. Please avoid the area between Oakwood and Elmwood on Maple when possible.
- Crews will be installing a fire hydrant near 6650 Maple Dr. Maple will be closed at this location for the duration of that work.
- Water service replacements will begin next week on Maple Dr. Crews will start on the west end of Maple Dr. and work east. The shut-off valve (curb-stop) in your yard will be replaced as well as the water line connecting your shut-off valve to the water main. If you would like to discuss your landscaping, please call me to meet with you.
- Repairs will be made on the sanitary sewer mainline on Maple Dr. between Oakwood Dr. and Elmwood Dr. These repairs will NOT affect the sewer service to your home. However, the road will be closed during the repairs.
- Temporary water has been installed for phase 1. If you have any questions regarding the temporary water system, please contact **Chad Linder with LaTour Construction @ 612-419-0436**.

## What can you do?

- Residents with underground dog fences located in the ROW should expect that a portion of the fence damaged, and the Resident will be responsible for any repairs.
- Avoid the area of Elmwood Dr. and Maple Dr. This area will be very congested for the next few weeks.

- Excavations during the project will require segments of each road, and intersections, to be closed to traffic at times. Residents will need to utilize alternate routes to commute to and from their home during these times.

  - Stay a safe distance from equipment and excavations.
  - Drive with caution throughout the construction project area, obeying construction signs.
